

Vermont Lanterns®

Care & Use Instructions - Hurricane Lanterns

FUEL: Use only approved Lamp Oil fuel: (Lamplight, Crown, Florasense, Aladdin, Sterno, Safe & Green, or Paraffin “Ultra Pure”). Citronella lamp oil or Kerosene can be used outdoors.

WARNING: DO NOT use gasoline, alcohol or “tiki torch” fuel.

FILLING: Do not fill more than 80% full. Use line in tank below filler cap as a max (8-10 fl oz). Overfilling can cause fuel to spill out of burner socket into air chamber above tank, which would then give the impression of leaking from side tube joints. Keep the lantern level; tilting at an angle can cause fuel to leak. Let new wick absorb fuel for 10 minutes before first lighting.

LIGHTING: Use the side lever to raise the globe and light the wick. Lower back down and adjust wick. Correct wick height is BELOW the burner dome. The wick is too high if you see smoke. To extinguish, lower the wick a little, push down lever to raise globe, and blow out.

WICK MAINTENANCE: The wick will need trimming occasionally. If the top is charred, trim with sharp scissors straight across.

GLOBE / WICK CHANGE:

Wait until lantern is cool. Lift the top cap ring upwards. The globe and cage can now tilt back (opposite filler cap) for cleaning or removing the burner and wick. Turn burner out of lock tabs to loosen. Feed new wick thru the bottom of the burner.

CAUTION:

- Never leave a burning lantern unattended.
- Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Glass globe and top cap will become hot during use.
- Keep lantern level on flat surface or hang by the handle.
